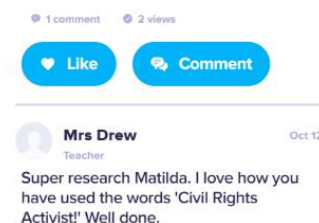
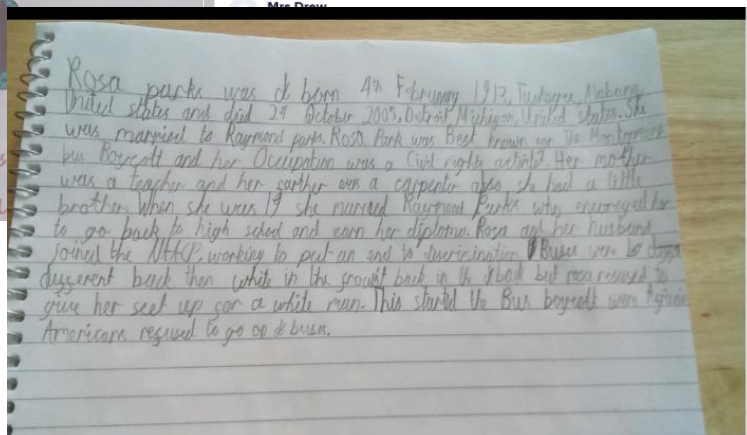
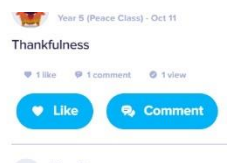


Parent/Carer Consultation Evening

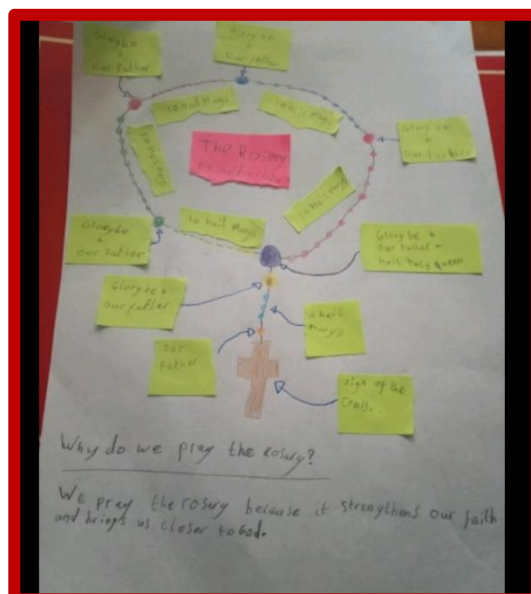
Together, we are a masterpiece!
